## A little information about Malvern Community Hospital



The original Malvern Hospital opened in 1911, and was a gift to the town from businessman and philanthropist C W Dyson Perrins, grandson of Worcestershire Sauce inventor William Perrins. All treatments as well as operations were carried out over the years until it became unfit for purpose and a new hospital was built.

The new state of the art Hospital was opened in 2010 when many of the facilities were transferred from the old Hospital. The Friends of Malvern Community Hospital helped equip the new Hospital with a wide variety of equipment for the benefit of patients and staff.

Malvern Community Hospital provides both in-patient and out-patient services to the local community including:  
 24 Beds for inpatients,  
 X-ray department  
 outpatients appointments  
 physiotherapy department  
 and minor injuries department to name but a few.



The Friends hold a variety of fund raising events throughout the year such as: Coffee Mornings, Summer and Christmas Fairs, Afternoon Teas, Pudding evenings etc. All these events are managed by our dedicated team of helpers, and without them we could not do it.

All monies raised go to purchase items for the hospital, whether it be large or small. If we can raise the funds we will then purchase it for them.
